Note that the order is different, as we have formatted and organized them as we should – alphabetically by the author’s name. Perhaps the most difficult thing in the Harvard system is working out which bits should be italicized and which in quotation marks. For books, the titles are italicized (or underlined); for journals, both printed and online, the title of the journal is italicized. Quotation marks go around chapters in books and titles of journal articles.
